### **Companies can find all information on IUCLID 5.2 on ECHA's website**

**On 15 February 2010, the new version of IUCLID 5 was made available to companies as documented in the News Alert ECHA/NA/10/04. Companies are advised to consult the websites of IUCLID 5 and ECHA for detailed information about the new version of IUCLID 5 and its link to the upcoming new version of REACH-IT.**

Before contacting ECHA's helpdesk, companies are advised to visit the ECHA and IUCLID 5 websites and to read the updated IUCLID 5 manuals and frequently asked questions (FAQs) of IUCLID 5 and REACH-IT.
