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# IUCLID software evolution

- Main versions of IUCLID software and ECHA REACH-IT:

Earlier versions IUCLID 5.0, 5.1 - 2007	OECD templates	REACH-IT v.1
IUCLID 5.2 – February 2010	Classification & Labelling according to CLP regulation	REACH-IT v.2.1
IUCLID 5.3 – February 2011	Template for authorization	REACH-IT v.2.2
IUCLID 5.4 – June 2012	New uses and exposure information, PBT assessment	REACH-IT v.2.4
IUCLID 5.5 – April 2013	Biocides products (and Active Substances) supported	
IUCLID 5.6 – April 2014	Update of the C&L format (4 <sup>th</sup> ATP) and nanomaterials templates	REACH-IT v.2.7
IUCLID 6.0 – Beta version May 2015	<b>Test version only</b> - new IT architecture and new IUCLID environment prior to the official release in 2016	Not supported by ECHA REACH-IT. Previous IUCLID versions 5.4 - 5.6 must be used.
IUCLID 6.0 – Official release planned for Q2 2016	User management revamped, new software requirements (GlassFish), new interface	Future release of REACH-IT v.3

Once the new version of ECHA REACH-IT is released (v 3, planned end of Q2 2016), IUCLID 6 will be mandatory to submit dossiers to ECHA.

IUCLID 5.6 (and older versions) won't be supported by ECHA REACH-IT v.3 (release in summer 2016).

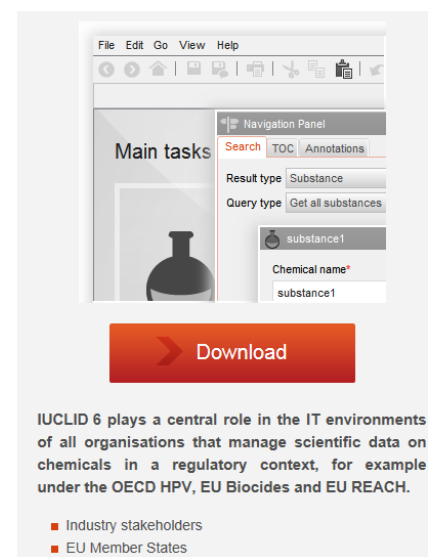

# ECHA advice on IUCLID 6 upgrade

## Migration from IUCLID 5 to 6



### Recommendations

- Further developments are planned in IUCLID 6 in 2015:
  - Format will be updated
  - Additional migration rules will be implemented for the final IUCLID 6 version to be made available in Q2 2016
- It is recommended to **update to IUCLID 5.6** now if not already done
- It is recommended to **test** the migration available with the IUCLID 6 beta release
- It is recommended to plan the migration of the **production** system
  - When IUCLID 6 is made available in 2016
  - Taking into account the workload under REACH:
    - Only IUCLID 5 dossiers will be accepted before REACH-IT 3 goes live
    - Only IUCLID 6 dossiers will be accepted after REACH-IT 3 goes live
    - There is no possibility to generate IUCLID 5 dossiers from a IUCLID 6 database
    - IUCLID 6 will be made available before REACH-IT 3 goes live, in Q2 2016



**IUCLID 5.6 is a pre-requisite for the migration to IUCLID 6 to ensure full compatibility**

# ECHA key messages on IUCLID 6

## Key messages



- ECHA will update its IT tools in Q2 2016
  - IUCLID 6
  - Chesar 3
  - REACH-IT 3
- Until then, IUCLID 5 and Chesar 2 have to be used
- The IUCLID 6 distributed version has new software requirements (GlassFish)
- For IUCLID 6, companies can already **test** the deployment and migration steps with the beta release scheduled for May 2015 and investigate if new functions available for user and data management can be used
- The migration of the **production** systems (IUCLID) should be planned for Q2 2016

## IUCLID 6 – Beta release

- IUCLID 6 beta version:
  - Preliminary test version of IUCLID 6
  - If you use IUCLID distributed version: IUCLID 6 beta release allows to prepare for the changes needed in the IT infrastructure and user management.
- If you have installed IUCLID directly on your desktop computer or laptop, you do not necessarily need to install the beta version. However, it will give you a chance to get familiar with the new look of the user interface and prepare for IUCLID 6 upgrade in 2016

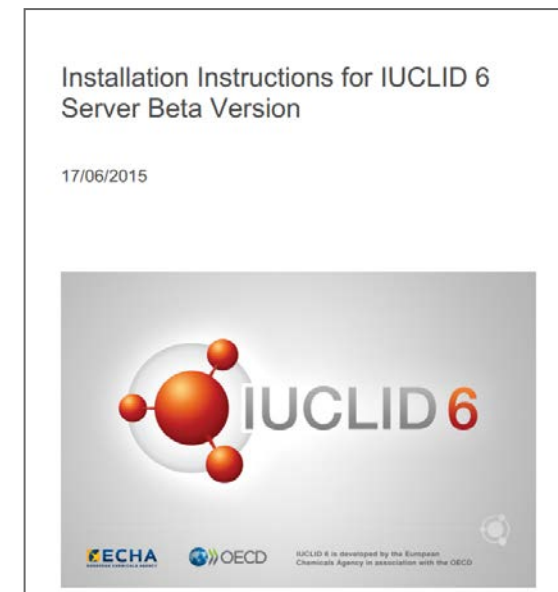


- **IUCLID 6 Beta** is a test version and **cannot be used to prepare official dossier for submission to ECHA**
- A **final upgrade of IUCLID 6** will be mandatory when it is released in Q2 2016
